

SPECIAL CONCERT PERFORMANCE MONTEVERDI'S 1610 VESPERS

On Saturday, December 4 and Sunday, December 5, Kairos will present the *Vespro della Beata Virgine (1610 Vespers)*, celebrating the 400th anniversary of Italian Baroque master Claudio Monteverdi's masterwork.

Published in Venice when the composer was a court musician for the Duke of Mantua, the *1610 Vespers* is Monteverdi's monumental sacred work for choir and chamber orchestra.

To celebrate the work's anniversary, Kairos presents a historically-informed performance of this great work using period instruments in the superb acoustics of the Holy Cross chapel. The event will also feature a pre-concert talk on this magnificent and seminal work 30 minutes before the concert.

Advance reserved tickets are \$20, \$15 seniors and \$7 youth/students, with limited \$25 general admission at the door. Visit www.kairosconsort.org for ticket order info.
